- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Hunsaker was seen for a .100 hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Twin Rivers Unit on January 8, 2019.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Hunsaker is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 82-1-02588-3 for Statutory Rape in the Second Degree Count II; Statutory Rape in the First Degree Count III; Assault in the Second Degree Count IV; Indecent Liberties Count V; Burglary in the First Degree Count VI; and Statutory Rape in the Third Degree Count VII.

The crimes involved Mr. Hunsaker, between his ages of 45 to 50 years, approaching six Asian children between the ages of eight and 16 at their

homes while their parents were not present. He gained entry under the guise of a school official who did physical exams. Mr. Hunsaker would take their measurements and then take the female children into the bathroom where he would sexually assault them. Mr. Hunsaker is currently 84 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a moderate to high risk to re-offend which may be lower with protective factors to include his age and health.

Mr. Hunsaker has had one serious infraction which occurred in December of 2015 for making pruno.

Mr. Hunsaker is currently working at a Therapy Aide and has been commended for his patience working with a difficult inmate. He is currently participating in the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment (SOTAP) Aftercare for the second time.

Mr. Hunsaker would like to release to his wife of 34 years. He would like to work part-time in his son's landscaping business where he would work in the office.

- **Decision**

The panel finds Mr. Hunsaker parolable.

- **Reasons:**

- **Most recent actuarials VRAG, SORAG and Static 99R all Low/Moderate**
- **Completed risk related programming; SOTAP X 2, Aftercare X 2, Bridges to Life**
- **One Serious Infraction during his entire incarceration**
- **Forensic evaluator reports he may be a reasonable candidate for reduction in custody level if he completes SOTAP with positive results**
- **Declining health and advanced age 84**
- **Extensive release plan**
- **Lifetime supervision**

- **Next Action:** Submit offender release plan (ORP).

Recommendations:

Mr. Hunsaker should enter into and successfully complete the community portion of SOTAP. He should have tight controls around access to minors.
