- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Cramm was seen for a release hearing on February 23, 2021 at the Airway Heights Corrections Center.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Rongen presented the case to the full Board

- Mr. Cramm is being seen by the Board for his convictions of Murder in the First Degree Counts I and II and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 2 in Snohomish County Cause 00-1-01051-1.

The crime involved the murder of two individuals as a result of multiple gunshot wounds received when their vehicle was fired upon by Mr. Cramm. Mr. Cramm was 16 years of age at the time of the crime and is currently 38 years of age.

Mr. Cramm has previous criminal history as a juvenile for Intimidating a Witness.

Risk assessments show Mr. Cramm to be a low to moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Cramm has incurred 40 serious infractions. The last one was in 2014 for refusing to disburse due to a fight with a cellmate, possession of sexually explicit material and possession of a tool for tattooing.

Mr. Cramm has completed several educational and vocational courses. He has also completed Human Relations, Thinking for a Change, and is currently participating in the Therapeutic Community and receives positive reports. He has also worked as a dog handler.

Mr. Cramm takes responsibility for his crime and appears remorseful.

Mr. Cramm would like to release to Spokane and has a possible job at Amazon Distribution. He has good support in the community.

- **Decision:**
The panel recommends Mr. Cramm be found releasable.
- **Reasons:**
 - Assessed as an overall low-moderate risk to reoffend when you combine his static and dynamic risk factors with his protective factors;
 - Has taken Non-Violent Communication, Redemption, Thinking for a Change and is participating in the Therapeutic Community;
 - No serious infractions for over 6 years;
 - Has obtained his AA Degree and has learned a number of work skills to assist him in the community;
 - Strong social support in the community to include resources for employment and financial support;
 - Will have three years of supervision.
- **Recommendations:**
 - Mr. Cramm will need to follow the recommendations for treatment upon discharge from the Therapeutic Community. His use of drugs should be monitored closely and he should attend sober support groups
- **Next Action:**
 - Submit Offender Release Plan (ORP)
