- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.
  
- Mr. Teaford was seen for a .100 hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on February 16, 2021.
  
- **Summary Discussion**  
Ms. Davis presented this case.

Mr. Teaford is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Mason County Cause 989 for Robbery in the First Degree.

Mr. Teaford has served on previous convictions under the Board's jurisdiction in Pierce County Cause 48813 for Burglary in the Second Degree – three counts; King County Cause 79-1-01691-4 for Robbery in the First Degree; and Mason County Cause 989 Escape in the First Degree; Assault in the Second Degree – two counts.

The crime involved Mr. Teaford and two co-defendants escaping from the Mason County Jail. One of the co-defendants held a correctional officer at knifepoint and another correctional officer was also overpowered. Once they escaped, they stopped a passing citizen in a vehicle and stole the car at gunpoint. While on escape Mr. Teaford fled to California and was apprehended approximately a week later. He was 23 years of age at the time of the crimes and is currently 62 years of age.

Mr. Teaford's overall risk to re-offend is high.

Mr. Teaford has committed nine infractions since his last hearing in September of 2019. Three of them are drug related.

Mr. Teaford is not currently programming or working and is not motivated to do so.

- **Decision:**
  - The panel recommends he be found not parolable and adds 48 months to his minimum term.
  
- **Reasons:**
  - He has received 9 serious infractions since the last Board hearing
  - He refuses Chemical Dependency treatment even though his recent infractions involve drug and alcohol possession and use. (recommended level of care 3.3)
  - He has not participated in any risk related programming since the last Board hearing
  - "Mr. Teaford scored in the High range for psychopathy, indicating that his risk for reoffending is high based upon the amount of psychopathy indicators present." - Dr. Lisa Robtoy Psy.D.
  - He shows serious lack of insight for his behavior
  
- **Recommendations:**
  - Mr. Teaford should work on remaining serious infraction free, remaining drug and alcohol free, and should be reassessed for chemical dependency treatment when he's ready to participate. He should also participate in any offender related programming that will address his risk to reoffend.

- **Next Action:**
  - Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
