- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.
- Mr. Graham was seen by the Board for a .100 Hearing on April 26, 2021 and the Airway Heights Corrections Center.
- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Davis presented this case to the full Board

Mr. Graham is under the Board's jurisdiction in Yakima County Cause 84-1-00413-0 for Statutory Rape in the First Degree. He was also convicted under the cause for Statutory Rape in the Second Degree which reached its statutory maximum on September 12, 1998.

The crime involved Mr. Graham taking nude photos of a 13-year-old female relative and sexually assaulting her. The 10-year-old female victim of the

Second-Degree Statutory Rape was also a relative. Mr. Graham was 36 years old at the time of the crimes and is currently 70 years of age.

Mr. Graham's prior criminal history includes Custodial Interference and Threats in 1981 and 1982. He also has two counts of Lewd Act with a Child in 1987 and Sexual Assault in 1988 – both in San Diego, California.

Mr. Graham is an overall moderate-high to high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Graham has a total of 20 infractions with the last one occurring in 2011.

Mr. Graham is not motivated, has not completed any programming since 2008, and refused to complete the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP). However, he has stopped getting in trouble on the unit and has serious health issues.

He will need to release to a facility that has around the clock care. He has the support of his ex-wife and daughter.

- **Decision:**
The panel recommends he be found parolable.

- **Reasons:**
 - Mr. Graham has not received any serious infractions since 2011;
 - He is a Level II sex offender for notification purposes, and he scored Low for both SOTAP Static 99-r & ESRC Static 99-R; RLC-Low;
 - Mr. Graham has not been a management risk and his deteriorating physical health mitigates his risk to reoffend; and he is going to require 24-hour medical care;
 - He has three years supervision.

- **Recommendations:**
 - Mr. Graham should seek medical attention at the VA hospital for his physical health. Strong controls should be placed around interaction with children and frequenting areas where children tend to congregate.

- **Next Action:**
 - Submit offender release plan (ORP).
