- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Box was seen by the Board for a .100 hearing on May 5, 2021 at the Monroe Correctional Complex - Washington State Reformatory.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Box is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause 84-1-01571-0 for Murder in the First Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Box murdering a known female. Both the family of Mr. Box and the victim lived in the same house for over two years. The night before the murder Mr. Box let the victim how he felt about her. He said she let him down gently but was clear she had no romantic interest in him. The

next morning, he killed her. He told a friend about the crime and asked for assistance getting rid of the body. His friend called the police. Mr. Box was 18 when he committed the crime and he is currently 55 years of age.

Mr. Box's overall risk to re-offend is low to moderate. His risk is further mitigated by his medical issues.

Mr. Box has had a total of three infractions during his entire incarceration.

Mr. Box has completed Re-entry, Non-Violent Communication and Spanish class. He was unable to complete any other programming during this period due to extensive medical issues.

Mr. Box has good community support to include his sister and Jewish Community Members. He would like to release to the Jewish Prison Transition Home by UW Medical.

- **Decision:**
The panel recommends he be found parolable

- **Reasons:**
 - Psychological report assesses him to be overall Low/Moderate risk.
 - He has life threatening medical issues that may mitigate his risk.
 - He has completed multiple programs to assist with mitigating his risk - Redemption, Non-Violent Communication, Re-Entry, and Bridges to Life.
 - He has positive behavior and incurred only three Serious Infractions in 37 years, none involved violence.
 - He has a detailed release plan with community support.

- **Recommendations:**
 - Mr. Box should have strong controls around romantic relationships. He should seek out mental health services and follow all recommendations.

- **Next Action:** Submit offender release plan (ORP).
