• **Summary Discussion**

Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Morgan was seen for a .100 Hearing on August 11, 2020 at the Stafford Creek Corrections Center.

Risk assessment scores rate him as low to moderate to re-offend. However, he did not participate in his psychological evaluation.

Mr. Morgan is under the jurisdiction of the Board in King County Cause #83633 for Murder in the First Degree while armed with a deadly weapon.

The crime involved Mr. Morgan and a co-defendant robbing and killing a man from a local bar. He confessed to a priest that he had been a witness to the homicide and reports indicate he wrote a letter expressing his remorse for taking a life. When questioned by the police, he admitted his participation in the crime. He now denies that he actually killed the victim and indicated it was his co-defendant. Mr. Morgan was 22 years old at the time of the crime and is currently 61 years of age.

Risk assessment scores show him to be a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Morgan has had 18 total serious infractions with the last one occurring in 2006 for refusing cell assignment.

- **Decision:**
 - The panel recommends that he be found not parolable and 60 months be added to his minimum term. Schedule .100 Hearing 120 days prior to PERD.

- **Reasons:**
 - **He has not completed the Board recommendations, participate in a MRP, as well as programming to mitigate his risk and assist with transition into the community.**
 - **He has not completed any additional risk related programs.**
 - **He refused to participate in the Psychological Evaluation preventing the Board from knowing his current risk is to the community.**

- **Recommendations:**
 - The Board recommended Mr. Morgan continue to have his medical conditions addressed and that he could be seen sooner by the Board if he determines he is ready to participate in a MRP as determined by the Board and the DOC.

- **Next Action:**
 - Schedule .100 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).
