- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. McVay was seen for a .100 hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on September 25, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mrs. Ramsdell-Gilkey presented this case.

Mr. McVay is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Whatcom County Cause 82-1-00332-1 for Rape in the Second Degree. He also has a Habitual Criminal finding.

The crime involved Mr. McVay sexually assaulted a known female. The victim was developmentally disabled and vulnerable by her advanced age. Mr. McVay was 30 years old at the time and is currently 67 years of age.

Mr. McVay has two previous convictions for Burglary in the Second Degree.

Mr. McVay has a long list of adjudicated offenses that were disclosed when he participated in the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program in 2006. He is highly sexually preoccupied.

Risk assessment scores rate Mr. McVay at a low risk for future violence and a moderate risk for sexual re-offending.

Mr. McVay's last serious infraction was in 2013.

Mr. McVay has completed limited programming, however he did complete SOTAP in 2006.

Mr. McVay was asked to complete a detailed release plan. He did not and can still only provide very little detail about a potential release plan.

- **Decision** – Not parolable add 36 months to his minimum term.

- **Reasons:**
 - Needs additional offense specific treatment as it has been a lengthy period of time since completing a sex offender treatment program.
 - Assessed by the ESRC as a level Three for community notification.
 - Has a large number of victims and with an offending history that spans decades.
 - His most recent Psychological Evaluation assesses Mr. McVay as a moderate risk for a future sexual re-offense.

- **Next Action:** Schedule .100 120 days prior to parole eligibility review date (PERD). A new psychological evaluation is required for the next hearing.

Recommendations: Mr. McVay should re-apply for SOTAP as the Board will be asking for an override for his participation. Additionally, the Board would like to see Mr. McVay participate in the Bridges to Life program.
