- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.

- Mr. Minish was seen for a .100 hearing at the Airway Heights Corrections Center on September 25, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Mrs. Ramsdell-Gilkey presented this case.

Mr. Minish is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Island County Cause 2732 for Indecent Liberties.

The crime involved Mr. Minish having sexual contact with an eight (8) year old girl he and his wife were babysitting. Mr. Minish was 30 years old at the time and is currently 70 years of age.

Mr. Minish was on probation for the Indecent Liberties when he absconded to Oregon and committed two counts of Sodomy in the First Degree in

Multnomah County Cause 85-06-32460. These crimes involved the sexual assault of two children. Mr. Minish served 20 years in Oregon and was returned to Washington. His probation was revoked and he was given a minimum term of 120 months on the Island County Cause. He also has a prior offense in Massachusetts in 1975.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a low to moderate risk to re-offend. However, due to lack of details in his criminal history, it is difficult to determine his risk to the community. A Forensic Psychological Evaluation has been ordered which will provide more insight into his risk.

Mr. Minish had a couple of serious infractions a couple of years ago.

Mr. Minish has completed very little programming and believes he is smart enough to solve his own problems and treatment would be counter-productive.

Mr. Minish does not care if he is released.

- **Decision** – Not parolable – Release on max ex of 12-2-2019
- **Reasons:**
 - Has completed no risk related offender programming
 - Minimizes behavior and sexual deviancy
 - Risk Level III for community notification purposes
 - Does not wish to be released prior to max
- **Next Action:** Release on maximum expiration date.
- **Recommendations:** Prior to release determine if Mr. Minish is to be considered to civil commitment.
