- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received. However, the original prosecutor recommendation was for Mr. Rodriguez to serve his full sentence.
- Arturo Rodriguez was seen for a release hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Twin Rivers Unit on October 2, 2018.
- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Rodriguez is being reviewed by the Board in Yakima County Cause 782887 for Murder in the First Degree.

The crime involved Mr. Rodriguez shooting a known male over a \$200.00 debt the victim owed to him. Mr. Rodriguez had previously threatened to hurt the victim or do something to his car if he did not pay his debt which

was related to a cocaine purchase. Mr. Rodriguez was 17 years old at the time and is currently 42 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate Mr. Rodriguez as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Rodriguez has had over 50 serious infractions with the last one in 2016 for interfering with count, a positive UA, fighting and having sexually explicit materials.

Mr. Rodriguez is not currently working, but he previously worked as a custodian. He has completed CBT, Bridges to Life, Breaking Barriers and Stress and Anger Management and is currently enrolled in English as a Second Language.

Mr. Rodriguez has an ICE Detainer for Mexico. He has a home in Tijuana and would like to live with his mother there. He also has family support from other family members.

- **Decision – Not** releasable. Mr. Rodriguez will not release under the jurisdiction of the Board.
- **Reasons:**
 - Over 50 Serious Infractions, last in 2016 - fight, positive urinalysis (UA) for methamphetamine, possession of sexually explicit materials
 - Gang member for years (has not debriefed but is at a “safe harbor facility” due to issues with La Fuma)
 - 16 negative Behavior Observations
 - No chemical dependency screening or treatment

- **Next Action:** Release on earned release date (ERD).

Recommendations: Mr. Rodriguez should be screened and enter into chemical dependency treatment to assess his treatment needs. He should also remain Serious Infraction free and improve his behavior.
