- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received recommending no release.

- Mr. Robinson was seen for a release hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Washington State Reformatory on October 16, 2018.

- **Summary Discussion**
Ms. Balmert presented this case.

Mr. Robinson was seen by the Board for his convictions in Kitsap County Cause 97-1-00661-7 for Rape in the First Degree, Rape in the Second Degree and Robbery in the First Degree; and Kitsap County Cause 97-1-01131-9 for Assault in the Second Degree.

The crimes involved him and his crime partner forcing their way into a home with a firearm and sexually assaulting a known female and forcing the other occupant in the house to perform sexual acts on that same female. On that

same day Mr. Robinson and his crime partner threatened another adult female with a shotgun demanding money. The next day they forced their way into another residence demanding money and allegedly shot the mail victim in the abdomen and fled the scene. On that same date they approached another male while pointing a gun and demanded his jewelry, shoes and money. Mr. Robinson was 17 years old at the time of these crimes and he is currently 38 years of age.

While incarcerated in Kitsap County awaiting sentencing for the aforementioned crimes, Mr. Robinson stabbed another inmate in the neck with a sharpened toothbrush.

Risk assessment scores rate him as a mod-high risk to re-offend.

Mr. Robinson has had 56 serious infractions during his incarceration

Mr. Robinson has completed thinking for a change (T4C), Alternatives to Aggression (A2A), Motivation Engagement, received a welding certificate and completed educational classes. He is on the list for Alternatives to Violence. He has refused to complete the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP).

Mr. Robinson has a girlfriend in Spokane and support from the Urban League.

- **Decision**

The Board finds Mr. Robinson not releasable. He can release on his earned release date (ERD) and will not be under the Board's jurisdiction.

- **Reasons:**

- 56 Serious Infractions, last one 2016 positive for THC
- Overall Moderate/High risk from Dr. Robtoy, PsyD, and not a good candidate for release.
- Declined Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP)
- No chemical dependency treatment completed
- End of Sentence Review Committee recommended a Level II risk classification for community notification purposes
- Minimal programming completed

- **Next Action:**

Release on ERD.

Recommendations:

Mr. Robinson should enter into and successfully complete the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) and chemical dependency treatment. He should also remain infraction free and take any offender change programs which will prepare him for release.
