- An updated prosecutor recommendation was received. They did not support Mr. Crenshaw being released.
- Rodney Crenshaw was seen for a .100 hearing on October 23, 2024 at the Airway Heights Corrections Center.

• Summary Discussion

Corey McNally presented the case to the full Board.

 Rodney Crenshaw is under the jurisdiction of the Board for their conviction of Murder in the First Degree in Whatcom County Cause 10006.

Mr. Crenshaw murdering his wife, on August 28, 1978, shortly after they were married. He was 27 years of age at the time of the crime and is currently 74 years of age.

Previous Criminal History:

Mr. Crenshaw's criminal history began as a juvenile with crimes such as aggravated burglary, disorderly conduct, resisting arrest and assault.

Risk assessments show him to be a low moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Crenshaw has an extensive history of serious infractions with the last one being in 2018.

Mr. Crenshaw has participated in many programs while incarcerated to include, Thinking 4 a Change, stress and anger management.

Mr. Crenshaw discussed HOM and Fare Start in King County.

Decision:

The panel recommends Mr. Crenshaw be released to the community.

• Reasons:

- Completed T4C 4-8-24.
- Actively engaged in mental health treatment.
- He has worked consistently since his arrival at AHCC MSU.
- He has been serious infraction free since 2018
- He demonstrates psychiatric stability.
- He is 74 years old.
- Dr. Robtoy's 2022 psychological evaluation indicates he is a reasonable candidate for release.
- Mr. Crenshaw has been successful transitioning to a lower level of custody at the AHCC Minimum Security Unit where he has not demonstrated interpersonal conflict or a change in his psychiatric stability since arriving there in December 2023.

Recommendations:

- Mental Health Treatment (including any prescribed medications)
- Substance Abuse Treatment, Assessment and Follow Recommendations
- Strong controls around alcohol use
- Strong controls around drug use
- Strong controls around relationships
- Internet Monitoring
- Electronic Monitoring

• Any additional structure and case management services for mental health medication and support.

• Next Action:

• Submit an Offender Release Plan (ORP) for consideration.
