- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.
  
- Mr. Agtuca was seen for a .100 hearing at the Monroe Correctional Complex – Washington State Reformatory on November 20, 2018.
  
- **Summary Discussion**  
Mrs. Ramsdell-Gilkey presented this case.

Mr. Agtuca is under the jurisdiction of the Board in Walla Walla County Cause 90-1-00246-0 for Assault in the First Degree with a finding of Habitual Criminal.

The Assault in the First Degree involved Mr. Agtuca and a crime partner stabbing another inmate at the Washington State Penitentiary where they were all incarcerated. He was 24 years of age at the time of his crime and he is currently 66 years of age.

He previously served on King County Cause 54034 for Robbery; King County Cause 58785 for Robbery, Counts I and II and Assault in the Second Degree; and Walla Walla County Cause 62328 for Assault in the Second Degree. All previously served causes and counts were also under the Board's jurisdiction.

Risk assessment scores rate Mr. Agtuca as a moderate to high risk to re-offend.

- Mr. Agtuca has had several Infractions, and has incurred a couple of serious infractions since his last hearing in 2013 but no violent infractions since 1993.
- Mr. Agtuca has completed Bridges to Life, Roots of Success, and is a Redemption Facilitator. He is currently involved in the White Bison Program and is working to get it established at the Reformatory at this time.
- Mr. Agtuca has submitted a well thought out release plan and receives regular family visits.
- **Decision:**  
The full Board finds Mr. Agtuca conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-Entry Plan (MRP) and adds 48 months to his minimum term to complete that transition.
- **Reasons:**
  - Has maintained employment throughout much of his incarceration
  - Has substantial community support and a well thought out release plan
  - Completed Roots of Success, Bridges to Life, some college courses and is a Redemption Facilitator
  - Involved in sober support through the White Bison program
- **Next Action:**  
Schedule .100 120 days prior to his parole eligibility review date (PERD).

**Recommendations:**

Transition through lower levels of custody beginning with 12 months in a camp setting followed by 6 months in a work release setting if eligible. Mr. Agtuca was advised that the Board expects him to remain serious infraction free and to cease incurring negative behavioral observations.
