- An updated prosecutor recommendation was not received.
  
- Mr. Alishio was seen by the Board at the Monroe Correctional Complex – MSU on December 7, 2018 for a .100 Hearing.

At a previous hearing on June 6, 2017 he was found conditionally parolable to a Mutual Re-entry Plan.

- **Summary Discussion**  
Mrs. Ramsdell-Gilkey presented this case.
  
- Mr. Alishio is under the Board’s jurisdiction in King County Cause 80-1-02215-2 for Rape in the First Degree Count I (While Armed with a Deadly Weapon) and Rape in the Second Degree Count III. Count III reached the statutory maximum on July 20, 1990.

Count I involved Mr. Alishio stopping to provide assistance to a woman who had run out of gas. When he returned with the gas, he leaned into the victim's car with a knife and told her he was going to rape her. He sexually assaulted the woman and took her wallet leaving his in her car. Mr. Alishio was arrested and released on his personal recognizance. Count III involved him raping an unknown woman who was walking along the highway. Mr. Alishio was 25 years old at the time and is currently 63 years of age.

Risk assessment scores rate Mr. Alishio as a moderate risk to re-offend.

Mr. Alishio has done well at the MSU at Monroe in the camp setting. He has completed Bridges to Life and the Crossroads program. He has completed the Sex Offender Treatment and Assessment Program (SOTAP) twice.

Mr. Alishio has a degree in Horticulture and he has won awards for his Origami and hopes to use his art to make money when released.

- **Decision:**  
The full Board finds Mr. Alishio parolable.
  
- **Reasons:**
  - **Completed the Crossroads Program at MSU as recommended by the Board**
  - **No serious infractions since 2010 and no violent infractions since 1994**
  - **Completed risk related treatment (SOTAP) in 1995 and again in 2017 to include aftercare**
  - **Risk likely reduced due to age and medical issues**
  
- **Next Action:**  
Submit Offender Release Plan (ORP)

**Recommendations:**

**Mr. Alishio will need to maintain absolute sobriety upon his release. He will be expected to complete the community phase of sex offender treatment and to participate in sober support groups regularly and consistently throughout his period of parole. It will be imperative that he establish a prosocial support system in the community as well. Mr. Alishio should be prohibited from driving a motor vehicle without a good deal of restrictions imposed. For instance he should be required to maintain an accurate mileage log, track all travel, not provide rides to any female, etc.**
