**V. Chairs Report**

- **Legislative Session** – Ms. Rongen provided an update on bills introduced this session:
  - SB 6530 Expansion of the Clemency and Pardons Board. This bill puts the “post-review” conviction process under Clemency and Pardons and


expands their Board and makes them paid positions. There will be a hearing on Tuesday, January 28.

- HB 2547 Post-Conviction Review. This would put these individuals under the ISRB. No hearing has been scheduled
  - SB 5819 Post-Conviction Review and removes us from DOC. This bill was introduced last session. No hearing has been scheduled
  - HB 2670 Residency Restriction for Sex Offenders. This removes the State pre-emption that does not allow local jurisdictions to enact residency restrictions for sex offenders. No hearing has been scheduled.
- **King County Public Defender's Association** – Ms. Rongen will provide training to the public defender's on Thursday, January 30, 2020 at their office in Seattle.
