- Quarterly Data Report, which is pulled by our RDA staff was reviewed and discussed.
- The ISRB staff have been working on updating the ISRB Mission, Visions and Values as well as Strategic Planning for 2023-2025. Ms. Rongen thanked staff for participating in the work on February 9<sup>th</sup> with Stellar and Associates. They have been key to the success in this process. Staff reviewed the report that Stellar and Associates provided from that work.

- The Mission, Vision and Values were updated with two modifications based on input from Staff and Board. They are an expansion on our diversity value and adding "evidence-based" in our Mission Statement:
  - Practicing diversity, equity, inclusion, and respect of all individuals.
  - The ISRB makes informed evidence-based decisions essential to public safety regarding the confinement or release of individuals under its jurisdiction.
  - The four priorities areas that the Board and Staff identified to work on for the next 1-3 years were: Internal/External Communication, implementing further the Structured Decision-Making Framework and data collection to tell our story. The Board has decided on the Internal/External Communication will be our focus for the upcoming year.
- Staff from the Kentucky Department of Corrections will be here at the end of June 2023 to learn about our Structured Decision-Making Framework; observe hearings and attend the Board Meeting.
