Upon completion of the Learning Center (LC) confined space entry awareness training, the following site-specific training will be completed prior to performing entry duties.

- Roles and responsibilities:** Review the roles and responsibilities of the Entry Supervisor, attendant, entrant, and rescue personnel.
- Emergency reporting:** Review of names/locations of local emergency responders, including telephone contact information. Review procedures for notifying emergency responders (e.g., notify shift/master control). Provide emergency responders with Confined Space Entry Permit upon arrival.
- Potential and known hazards:** Review of facility map and master list of confined spaces. Training on known and potential hazards and mitigation strategies for each hazard.
- Confined space permit:** Permit procedures to include how to fill out the form properly, where and when to post the permit, and permit retention requirements.
- Emergency retrieval equipment:** Demonstration on the proper use of an evacuation harness, tripod/winch, ropes, and lanyards. Review inspection and maintenance requirements of equipment.
- Air testing equipment:** Demonstration on proper use, care, and maintenance. Instruction on operational methods, sensory function, bump testing requirements, and logging of test results.
- Ventilation equipment:** Demonstration on proper use, care, and maintenance. Instruction on operational methods necessary for effective ventilation.
- Communications equipment:** Location of hand-held radios. Demonstration of proper use, care, and maintenance, including charging of batteries to ensure reliability.
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Location of PPE necessary for confined space entry, including respirators' proper use, care, and storage.
- Other controls** (e.g. lighting, ladders, ropes): Location of equipment. Demonstration of proper use, care, and maintenance, including regular inspections to ensure reliability.
