



# CONSENT TO BE INTERVIEWED BY IMMIGRATION CUSTOMS AND ENFORCEMENT (ICE)

An Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agent would like to interview you. **Anything you say to the ICE agent may be used to deport you.**

**You do not have to speak with the ICE agent and there is no penalty if you refuse.**

Even if you agree to the interview, **you do not have to answer every question.** For example, you may choose to answer questions about yourself, but refuse to answer questions about your family members or friends or their workplaces and residences. **If you choose to be interviewed by the ICE agent, you are not required to sign any documents or agree to be fingerprinted or photographed by the ICE agent.**

Pick **ONE** of the following and sign your name:

- I do not agree to be interviewed by the ICE agent.
- I only agree to be interviewed by the ICE agent **with my lawyer present.**  
I understand that the Washington State Department of Corrections will not pay my lawyer's fees.
