Service Animals

Service animals may accompany people with disabilities onto prison grounds provided they follow all guidelines.

Guidelines:

- The animal must not be noisy or aggressive.
- The animal cannot interact with anyone besides the handler.
- The animal must accompany the handler at ALL times.
- The animal must stay off the furniture.
- The handler must keep the animal under control at all times.
- The animal cannot be fed or receive snacks.



Pets

Pets are not allowed on prison grounds. No Exceptions.

You may be asked:

- If the animal is a service animal.
- What service or task is the animal trained to do for you.

If your animal is engaging in inappropriate or disruptive behavior such as wandering around, barking, eating, or nipping/biting, the service animal may be asked to be removed from the facility and it cannot remain on facility grounds. The facility may not allow you to return to visitation for the remainder of that day.

Pets that are not service animals are not authorized.

It is a misdemeanor to falsely represent a pet as a service animal.
