#### **Current Status**

The Washington State Department of Corrections is pleased to announce that <u>Safe Start Corrections</u> <u>Visitation</u> is moving forward, with first visit sessions occurring on May 9, 2021.

Approved visitors are now able to access the online <u>COVID-19 Prison Visit Appointment Request</u> form to schedule their visit, with first visit sessions beginning on May 9, 2021. Visits will occur once a month, for one hour, to equitably allow time for as many individuals as possible to have time to visit, while ensuring COVID-19 safety and sanitation protocols are followed. Although in-person visitation is designed as nocontact, it allows incarcerated individuals and their visitors to safely spend time together in person.
