Current Status

The Washington State Department of Corrections' (DOC) COVID-19 bulletin transitioned from once a week on Wednesdays to twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays starting on September 14, 2021. DOC recognizes the importance of communicating regularly and effectively as COVID-19 cases continue to rise across Washington State.

- 9,026 Incarcerated Individuals have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
- 3,917 Staff* have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine
