Purpose – to get information related to the COVID 19 outbreak out to the families to help them understand the steps being taken by DOC to keep the Incarcerated Individuals safe and healthy. We are doing this on a weekly basis.

Sanitation-All incarcerated individuals were issued another bar of soap. Bandanas have been issued to all and CI masks have been issued to all the population.

Testing – We are still testing for COVID 19 when individuals are showing symptoms and, currently no positive results for CBCC. Currently we have 2 individuals in isolation and 25 in quarantine.

Social Distancing- We are still working on social distancing for everyone. Staff and Incarcerated Individuals are reminded to remain 6 feet from others.

Screenings –Staff are still being screened on each shift and refused entry if showing symptoms. If any incarcerated Individuals report or show signs of symptoms they are screened by medical and if deemed symptomatic they are isolated.

Notifications- We are meeting with tier reps weekly to inform incarcerated individuals of what is happening with COVID-19 here at CBCC. We have started sending minutes of these phone calls to offenders whose family members are involved through our kiosk system so they know what was discussed.

Questions from Family members:

Question – Is CBCC still receiving offenders from chain bus?

Answer – We did not have a chain bus this week

Question – Have meal portion sizes changed?

Answer- Per the Governors executive order, menus have changed but caloric content meets the requirements for individuals. Bags of chips have been removed from the lunch meal and replaced with carrot sticks or other healthier choices.
