Weekly Update

- Total for this outbreak since January 8th is 900. 44 on isolation status, 198 on quarantine status. The number is a little different since last meeting due to some recovered individuals coming off those numbers. BA, DB, E, and F are on a COVID status. C unit was just placed on a limited cluster status due to staff members testing positive in this area. C unit was tested, and their results came back good, no impact to visitation. On Sunday, we have started a new yard schedule to allow individuals who are on isolation and quarantine to have time out in the yard. They should be able to go out to the yard twice a week for about an hour each time.
