Therapeutic Community	Update from Supt. Miller	Family council members recently had questions concerning the Therapeutic Community (TC) Program at Larch Corrections Center. A decision has been made to put the program on pause while some administrative issues are resolved. In the meantime, a lower level of care will be offered for those that qualify. The Intensive Day Treatment (IDT) program is a substance abuse group that will consist of 2 hours in the morning and 2 in the afternoon, 4 days a week typically for 12 weeks. If feasible, we will attempt to also have evening classes for those who work during the day. For those residents
