Weekly Update

So far we have done 20,349 tests on staff and contractors. During the period of 12/18 thru 12/24 we have had 1 staff test positive.

COVID Unit - 14 on Isolation; all are Violators. 7 on Quarantine, 6 are Violators and 1 from Work Release.

All MCC Living Units are off Quarantine.

Both WSR and SOU were released from Quarantine Wednesday 12/22/20.

Although Incarcerated Individuals are back to work in Correctional Industries, CI staff are still running short. Overtime has been approved into next week to catch up in some areas.

I've received several concerns from both the incarcerated and family members regarding heat in WSR C/D Units. D unit reporting it is too hot, C unit too cold. Maintenance is working on it.

Ongoing issues with cable television. The problem is that we are wired for analog and need to switch to digital. Maintenance is trying to patch it together.

Comments/Closing

A lot of clarifying questions regarding Quarantine, Isolation and Cohorting. Currently, we are utilizing Cohorts by separating the living units during recreation, and while working in the Correctional Industries Kitchens

throughout MCC. Education and Religious programs do not cohort at this time which is why we continue to emphasize the importance of social distancing, proper use of masks, hand washing, cleaning of high touch surfaces and proper wearing of masks at all times.
