### Question 1

With the rise of COVID cases in Mason County, are you in contact with the County Health Department?

Answer

### Question 2

I understand there is a water issue?

Answer

Elevated levels of lead were found during routine testing of our water. The Department of Health did not put restrictions on our water usage. Abnormal tests require we must comply with protocols including additional testing to be done by our Environmental Specialist and Department of Health. 2 additional tests have been taken and results are pending. DOC/MCCCW took additional steps to move to bottled water, as an additional precaution.

### Question 3

I have been told the mental health of the facility is a concern. What are you doing to help with this?

Answer

Our Mental Health staff is available to our population with no change in services provided. During this morning's COVID assessment of the entire facility, Mental Health staff accompanied Health Service staff, during their rounds, as additional support.
