### Question 1

When will MCCCW individuals get vaccinated?

Answer

Due to the overwhelming need for vaccines at facilities with outbreaks, MCCCW will be lower on the list to receive vaccinations. No schedule has been announced to date.

### Question 2

Some facilities are vaccinating staff.

Answer

Yes, facilities with outbreaks are including staff for vaccinations.

### Question 3

What is being done to ensure staff don't come into facility with symptoms?

Answer

The daily prescreening process requires staff to be open and honest with answering health questions prior to accessing the facility. As well as individuals need to let someone know if they are not feeling well.

### Question 4

How can we ensure every incarcerated individual has the most current release of information document in their medical file?

Answer

Form was offered in units. It is up to the individual to fill-out form and get to Medical. Not able to force an individual to complete form.
