## Weekly Update

- Population Update – Total Population 131  
53 in Bear Creek Unit      39 in Mission Creek Unit      39 in Gold Creek Unit
- 11 individuals were transported to Washington Corrections Center for Women (WCCW) for COVID isolation.
- Most recent 2 individuals, who tested positive, are housed at MCCCW in the gym designated as Alternative Housing Unit. Going forward, any additional positive COVID cases will be housed at MCCCW.
- 7 individuals who were isolated at WCCW have returned to MCCCW.
- Gold Creek Updates
  - 39 individuals are in quarantine.
  - Showers and phone access are being rotated.
  - Implementation of a cohort yard schedule will be in place by end of today.
  - TV with DVD players have been issued to each tier allowing individuals to watch movies in the cell.
  - Unit will be tested, today with results available in a couple of days.

### Question 1

Do you have additional staff assigned to MCCCW during this outbreak?

Answer

Additional medical staff are onsite to help clinic staff. Any additional staffing needs will be coordinated with Headquarters.

### Question 2

What do the individuals in the gym have available to them?

Answer

We brought in portable restrooms and showers for their use, they have a television and DVD player for access to movies along with board games.

### Question 3

How are the staff doing?

Answer

Staff morale is pretty good.

### Question 4

Do you need any movies?

Answer

Chrislee McConnaughey has agreed to accept newly purchased movies, for distribution to Gold Unit and Gym.
