## WEEKLY UPDATES:

### 1. SCCC'S CURRENT COVID-19 NUMBERS:

2. **GTL** - The phone issue has been narrowed down to a recently installed Comcast Modem. They are aware and are working with GTL for resolution. This is a recent problem that started about 10 days ago. The previous issues have been dealt with.

3. **JPay** – JPay was contacted about the kiosk not working properly for a week in H2. Per CUS Wakefield, this issue has been resolved. In addition, reports have come from H1 A pod JPay kiosk being out of order. CPM Bohon has notified JPay/Securus of the issue and they responded saying the issue is being looked into for resolution.

## Last Week's Follow-up Question -

**COMMISSARY PIZZA PLATFORMS** - Due to shelf life issues, many products cannot be supplied for the incarcerated population. However, here are a few ways incarcerated individuals are making pizzas across the state:

Bagel -

1. Put the pepperoni down first on piece of cardboard in the shape/size of bagel, then all the ingredients.
2. Place it in the microwave for 1 ½ minutes.
3. Place bagel on ingredients upside down, place bagel with ingredients in microwave for 30 seconds.
4. Eat & enjoy.

Tortilla –

1. Place all ingredients on tortilla and microwave for 1 ½ minutes.
2. Remove from microwave, fold in half like a calzone.
3. Eat & enjoy.

Ramen –

1. Open 1 package of ramen, run under water to moisten, break in half.
2. Add ingredients to each half and microwave for 1 minute. Ramen should crisp up.

Population asking for English muffins to be added to commissary: Unfortunately, they have a short shelf-life of 2 weeks in comparison to a bagel which has a 90 day shelf-life and a tortilla which has a 60 day shelf-life.

Raw pizza crusts are not allowed due to containing yeast and yeast is considered a security concern.
