## Pre-Submitted Questions

### Question 1

**Grubaugh** – 25 in quarantine seems like a lot for one week. There is a rumor, if they go out for medical, they are quarantined when they come back. Some of the guys did not want to go and did not know they were going.

**Answer:** Superintendent Dan White clarified that the rule is not true and the quarantine mentioned is only related to the chain bus being quarantined due to circumstances. We had one bus with someone who was symptomatic, therefore the whole bus was quarantined.

### Question 2

**Racus** – There is a rumor that those in quarantine or ISO are pooping on their food trays.

**Answer:** Superintendent Dan White- That is a rumor. We had one in IMU who did that. We are required to sterilize trays after each use.

### Question 3

**Grubaugh**- Rumor from a CO that visitation won't start until we are in Phase 4.

**Answer:** CPM Justin Schlagle – Our visitation starts in Step 3. We don't coordinate with the State's phased approach.

**Answer 2:** Director Carlson- We spend at the least, 3 weeks in in Step.
