# LICENSE PLATE UPDATE

- We have started receiving new equipment
- Working with Capital Projects and WSP Maintenance to obtain required permitting for electrical work and area modifications
- Plates to continue being produced in current shop until new shop is ready to open
- First priority will be bringing digital printers and laminator online
- Still much to be done in regard to:
  - Electrical and physical plant work
  - Receiving all equipment
  - Installing all equipment
  - Hiring of workers from the medium units
  - Training staff and workers on new equipment
  - Ensuring receipt of new materials
  - Fine tuning of production processes and flow

- Two (2) blanking lines
- Fourteen (14) "suitcase" presses
- New tooling and dies
- Assorted powered and unpowered carts
- Electric forklift for use inside the shop
