**SUBJECT:** MI1 and MIG Custody Assignment

In the Department's ongoing efforts to transition individuals from incarceration back into the community, and to be consistent with RCW 9.94A.728 and RCW 72.65, the following are effective as of July 27, 2025, and will be reflected when the associated policies are updated:

## DOC 300.380 Classification and Custody Facility Plan Review

- V. Custody Level Designation and Eligibility
  - D. Minimum Custody: CRS 56 and above
    - 3. Minimum Custody MI1
      - a. MI1 custody will be assigned to individuals who are score Minimum and being placed in a Reentry Center as a participant, and
        - 1) Are within 18 <del>12</del> months of release
    - 4. Minimum Custody MIG
      - a. MIG Custody will be assigned to individuals who are:
        - 2) Between 6 and <u>18</u> <del>12</del> months to ERD

## DOC 310.150 Reception, Initial Classification and Custody Facility Plan

- II. Initial Classification and Eligibility
  - G. Minimum Custody: ICD 48 and above
    - 3. Minimum Custody MI1
      - a. MI1 Individuals with less than <u>18 12</u> months to ERD and meet the criteria in DOC 300.500 Reentry Center Screening may be placed in a Reentry Center.
